- 1. Gary Downey called the meeting to order. Jamie Bennett moved, and Tim Collins seconded that, if there are no objections, the Board use a "consent agenda" system for the Minutes and Financial Reports that Board members have received prior to a meeting. The motion passed.

- 4. Gary also advised tabling the rest of the present agenda items due to time.
